HELPFUL TRASH/RECYCLING GUIDELINES

TRASH COLLECTION:



Collection Days: Monday & Thursday

- Regular collections will be made when a holiday falls on a Monday or Thursday
- Collections WILL NOT be made on Christmas & New Years Day – collections after these holidays will be made the NEXT REGULAR COLLECTION DAY

Collection point for Trash is:

- The curb nearest the front of your home, or at the rear of homes with garages located on alleys
- All trash must be in a covered trash container
 - Do Not leave trash out in paper or plastic bags alone. This creates unclean and potentially unsanitary conditions
- Trash cans must be stored out of sight and not placed at the curb/alley prior to 5pm the evening before the trash collection day

PLEASE DO NOT:

- DO NOT place large items such as furniture out for the regular trash collections as the trash company will not accept them. To arrange pick up please contact Potomac Disposal at 301-294-9700 or <https://www.potomacdisposal.com/bulk-pickup/>
- DO NOT PLACE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SUCH AS PAINT, OILS, OR OTHER SIMILAR ITEMS IN THE TRASH! It is against Montgomery County Law. Household hazardous waste must be disposed of at the County Transfer Station in Gaithersburg - <https://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/sws/dropoff/>

RECYCLING COLLECTION:



Collection Days:

- Tuesdays – Lake Geneva Way, Mediterranean Drive, Autumn Mist Drive & Circle, Rushing Water Way, and Harmony Woods Lane
- Wednesdays – all other homes

Collection Point for Recycling is:

- The curb nearest the front of your home or at the rear of homes with garages located on alleys.
- Recyclables must be in a “blue bin” provided by Montgomery County. If you need a “blue bin”:
 - Call 311
 - Order via <https://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/sws/>

Examples of what may be recycled:

- Cardboard
- Newspapers – in a paper bag, tied in a bundle, or in recycle container.
- Glass bottles/jars – soda, juice, beer, wine, pickle jars, etc.
- Aluminum and Tin cans – soda, beer, tuna, pet food, vegetables, pie tins, aluminum foil products
- Plastic bottles/containers – with a 1 or 2 recycling symbol on bottom such as: milk, soda, juice, dish soap, laundry detergent and bleach bottles.

You should:

- Empty & Rinse all containers to be recycled
- Discard caps and lids

IMPORTANT NOTES: On **NON-COLLECTION DAYS**, trash and recycling receptacles **MUST NOT** be stored in public view. They must be stored in your rear yard, garage, or inside the home.

Townhome and single-family homeowners are **PROHIBITED** from leaving garbage or bulk-trash in the Fountain Hills Condominium. The trash corrals on Sparkling Water Drive are for the exclusive use of Condominium residents. The Condominium will call the police and prosecute violators who trespass on their property.
